






State of play – transnational cooperation



■ TNC notifications (min. 2 MS involved)










State of play – transnational cooperation



Number of projects










State of play – transnational cooperation





Developing local strategic approaches to address green issues

- **EGD themes relevant for LAGs** local food, short supply chains, circular economy, and sustainable mobility are particularly important
- integrate 'green issues' demonstrate the benefits to the local community and economy
- Better information for LAG boards and members and managers
- Capacity and expertise support and involvement of external expertise for LAGs









Key success factors to address 'green issues' locally

- Ensure local ,embeddedness' Connect projects to local issues, themes, places and history,
- Demonstrate how projects facilitating the green transition can address local problems,
- Highlight local opportunities,
- Communicate and deliver on the message that 'nobody is left behind'









Designing LEADER for resilience and sustainability

- Social resilience ,caring' community, strong volunteerism,
 LAG support to local organisations
- Environmental resilience through strengthening local ownersip of local resources and climate awareness
- Economic resilience synergies among local initiatives and strengthening local SME support









Resilience – needs and delivery system features

- Building back better
- 'Re-learning' the LAG territory and studying the ,hidden' impacts of the COVID pandemic
- Developing local innovation ecosystems
- Re-designing and upgrading local partnerships
- Creating local links to EGD and other EU policy priorities
- Flexibility for LAGs to revise and adapt their local strategies
- Stronger role for animation reflected also in LAGs' human resources
