ARIA 2024: 'Empowering young people'

The CP team have greatly enjoyed reading all the interesting and varied submissions for this year's ARIA awards – thank you so much for the great efforts put in by all the project promoters and Networks. What a tough task it has been to whittle down the 103 projects from 21 Member States to a shortlist of 24!

The shortlist has been communicated to the respective NNs and they are asked to keep this information confidential until the popular vote is launched at the end of October.

Invitations will be sent very shortly to the project promoters for the <u>Awards Ceremony</u> being held_in Brussels on 4 December. This year the projects can be supported at the ceremony by up to two representatives of their NN, these invitations will also follow shortly. Please help us by **ensuring you and your projects register as soon as possible.**

LAG Directory

The <u>LEADER LAG Directory</u> currently features 1 166 Local Action Groups from 19 Member States. It is being updated on an ongoing basis as we receive information from Member State Managing Authorities. LAGs can now be searched for by the key themes, linked to their Local Development Strategies (LDS), that will be the focus of their work.

This is the first phase of the LAG Directory, the next stages will be to include more information on individual LAG profiles and a partner search tool.

2) Gen Z: Leading Generational Renewal in Farming

Upcoming EU CAP Network workshop on National Networking

Following the first EU CAP Network workshop 'National Networking for Innovation in 2023, the EU CAP Network is organising its next workshop dedicated to national networking for innovation in the last week of January 2025.

The overall aim of the workshop remains similar to the one in 2023: to create opportunities for peer-to-peer learning and inspirational exchange on experiences, approaches, and good practice in networking for innovation and knowledge exchange between the National Networks as well as other stakeholders. This workshop will in particular also strengthen existing and building new collaborations between different stakeholders. The main target audience for the workshop will be the CAP National Networks, Managing Authorities, AKIS Coordination Bodies and Paying Agencies.
